

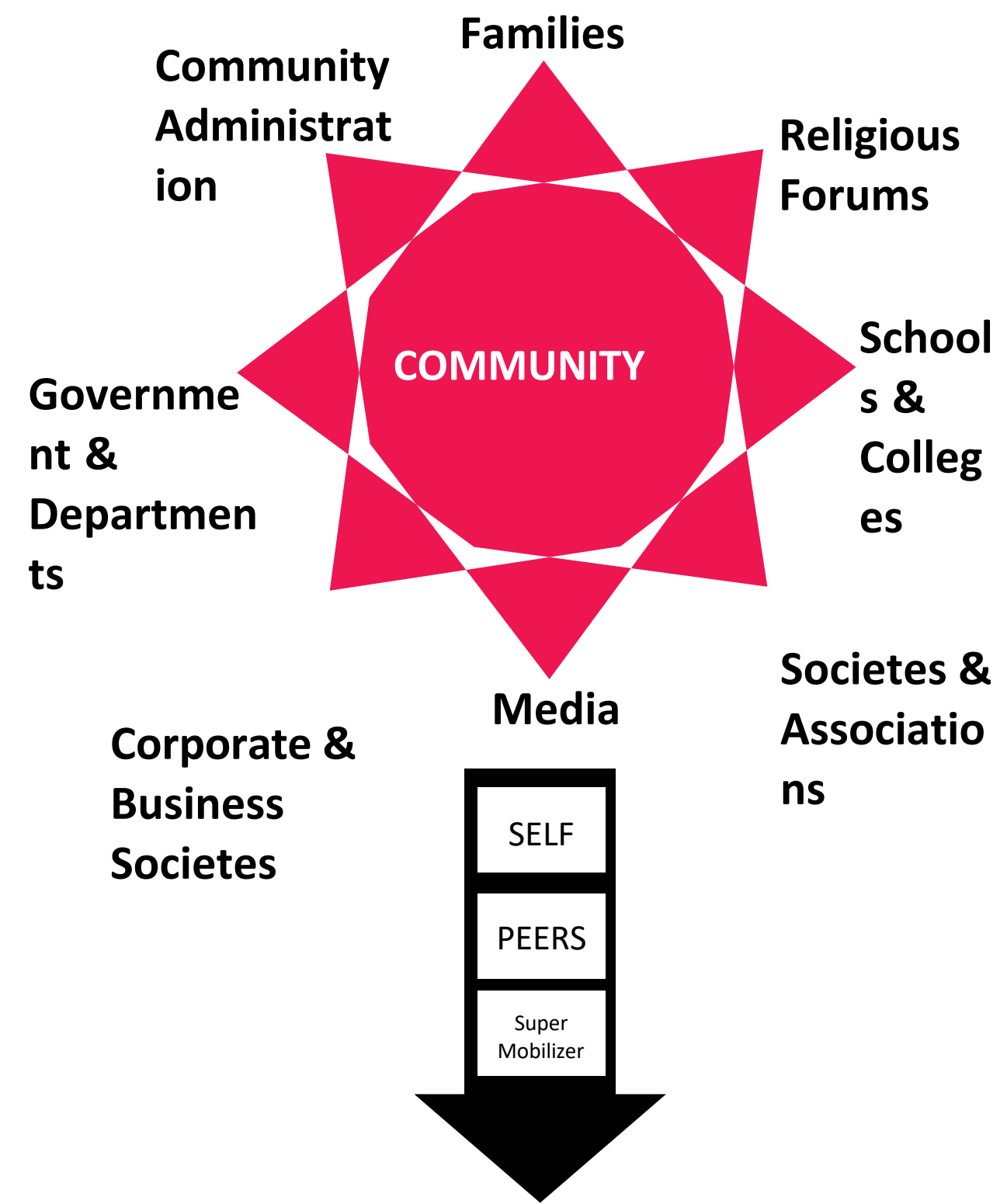

1. SERVICE DELIVERY

Service delivery is a fundamental input to population health status, along with other factors, including social determinants of health.
